GUIDELINES SPECIFIC TO JOHNSTON HEIGHTS STUDENTS ONLY

1. As there are multiple versions (outdated) of these scholarships online, the ONLY site you should download the application form from is: <https://www.surreyschools.ca/page/11480/post-secondary-scholarships> OR go to the School District's website (surreyschools.ca)/Students/Scholarships. You can apply for as many as you are qualified for!
2. Only typed applications will be accepted
3. The DUE date for your application is Tuesday, April 11th, 2023 by NO LATER than 3:00 PM - NO exceptions will be made; the computer's time stamp will be used. It is to be submitted to Ms. Domingo electronically (domingo_e@surreyschools.ca). The subject line of your email should have: **Name of the Scholarship application you are submitting - Your Last Name, Your First Name - 045**. Do not send it through Teams.
4. All components of the application should be included with the exception of your Diploma Verification Report (*course credits). Ms. Domingo will include it in later so there is no need to ask your counsellor, teacher or administrator (Vice-Principal). If you are applying for a scholarship requiring verification of financial need from your counsellor and administrator (Vice-Principal), you will need to complete your applications, fill out (type) their names onto the form, send it to the people you need signatures from with the instruction to forward it to Ms. Domingo immediately afterwards.
5. If your application requires reference letters, please provide your letter writers the Student Profile form found on our school's website: Departments/Careers/under Resources. Do it now as these letters will need to be submitted with your application. Please remember that these letters need to have all the requirements outlined fulfilled (eg. physical or digital signature, on official letterhead of organization).
6. Any unoriginal, "paraphrased", uncited and/or incorrectly cited work submitted will cause automatic disqualification. No exceptions!
