SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS GOALS

The establishment of good school-community relations and the maintenance of a positive image is vital to the goals of education in the school district.

The Surrey Board of Education is aware of its responsibility in maintaining open lines of communication with the general public, community organizations, other educational organizations and other public groups. It is also aware of its responsibility to provide the public with information and opportunities leading to participation directly or indirectly in the establishment of programs and policies that are in the best interests of the students of the school district.

The board recognizes that intelligent, informed support of schools is dependent upon knowledge, understanding and participation in the efforts, goals, and programs of the school district. Achieving these objectives requires that the board and staff, individually and collectively, express positive attitudes towards schools in their daily contacts with parents, the community and one another.
