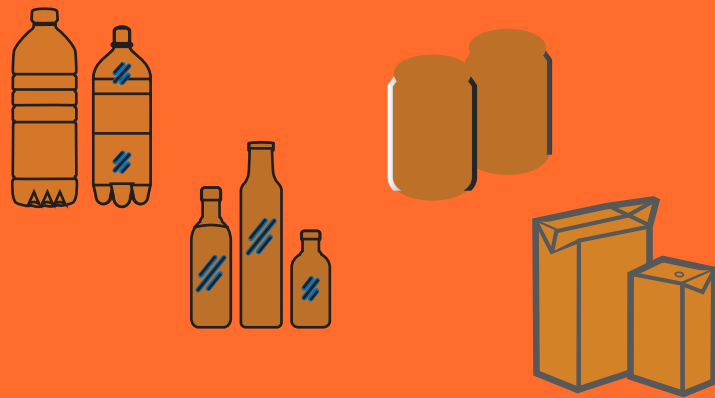

NOT ACCEPTED IN RECYCLING

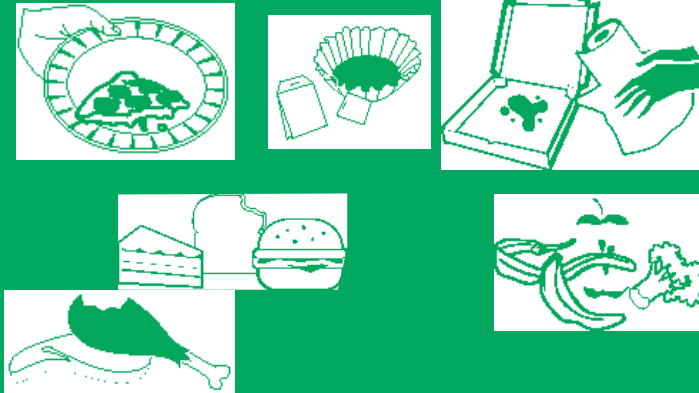


- Styrofoam

- Syringes or medical waste
- Batteries

ORGANICS



- All food items: proteins, dairy, fruits and vegetables, breads, grains, bones
- Tea bags, coffee filters and grounds
- Food-soiled paper
- Yard waste, woodchips and sawdust



NOT ACCEPTED IN ORGANICS



- Plastics of any kind (including bio-plastic, degradable plastic and compostable plastic)
- Film plastic bags
- Paper products soiled with cleaning supplies, chemicals, blood or other bodily fluids
- Personal tissues (Kleenex®)
- Biology specimens
- Glass or metals
- Electronic Waste
- Chemicals
- Clothes and textiles
- Cleaning products
- Biohazardous waste (such as sharps: syringes, EpiPens, lancets)
- Pesticides

GARBAGE



ONLY ITEMS WHICH
CANNOT BE RECYCLED
OR COMPOSTED



NOT ACCEPTED IN GARBAGE



- Batteries (automotive and household)
- Car parts and tires
- Automotive fluids, containers and filters (antifreeze, gasoline, used oil)
- Compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs)
- Commercial or industrial waste
- Construction or demolition materials (such as lumber and drywall)
- Curbside recyclables
- Electronics
- Flammable liquids, gasoline, paint and pesticides
- Liquids
- Medications
- Biomedical waste (including syringes and needles)
- Propane tanks
- Small appliances
- Yard and food waste
- Wood (clean or treated)
