

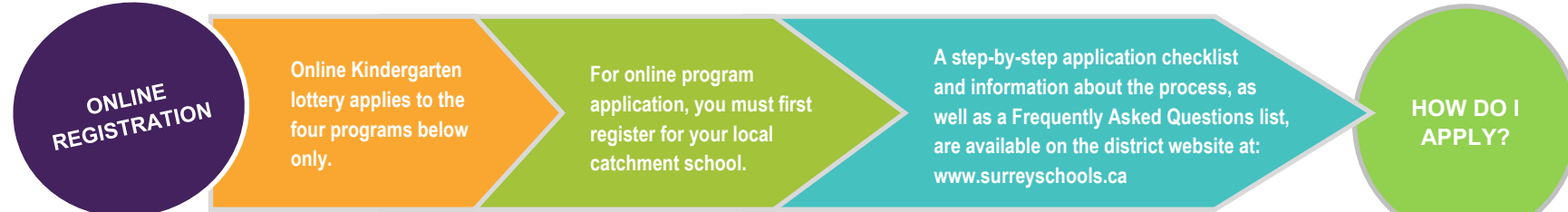

Children who will turn five years old before January 1, 2023 are eligible to begin school in September 2022.



Parents must register their child online for their local catchment school prior to applying for the Kindergarten lottery.

The lottery application will begin online Monday, January 24, 2022 at 8:00 am. Parents will have up until Friday, February 11, 2022 to apply, edit and/or change their application.

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WHAT IS THE TIMELINE?

January 10 - Regular Kindergarten registration opens for your local school.

January 24 - Online lottery application opens.

February 9 - Last day to register for catchment school in order to apply online for Kindergarten lottery.

February 11 - Online application closes.

February 22 to March 11 - Random draw takes place.

RESULTS/ WAITLISTS

During the weeks of **February 22 - March 11** an email will be sent to all applicants announcing the lottery results. The email will indicate whether your child has received a space in one of your selected choices and outline the next steps to accept or decline. Applicants not offered a space are automatically placed on a waitlist.

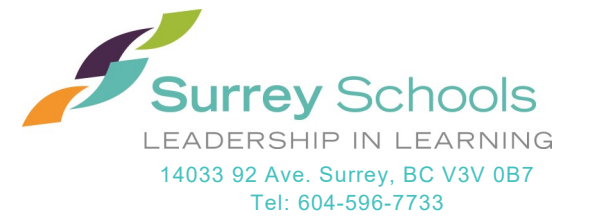
To register, contact your local school (for school catchment areas call 604-595-6308 or visit www.surreyschools.ca/K-12Schools/LocateSchool/Pages/default.aspx).

Surrey School District is now using a web-based online registration form. Once submitted, the form and any supporting documents will be available to school staff and the Principal who will use their judgment to determine if documentation requirements have been satisfied. The following documents are required to complete the registration process and may be uploaded to the registration portal or presented in-person at the catchment school or school-of-choice.

- Proof of birth date for the student (Birth Certificate or Passport).
- Proof of guardianship (as shown on child's Birth Certificate or other appropriate legal documentation such as Landed Immigrant Document or guardianship order).
- Proof of citizenship for both the parent and student (Canadian Birth Certificate, Citizenship Card, Passport, Landed Immigrant Document, Permanent Resident Card, Enhanced Driver's License or Enhanced Identification Card).
- Proof of residence (e.g. ordinarily resident) of parent/guardian in BC:
 - Three pieces of identification showing the address of residence (purchase or rental agreement, utility bill, Driver's License, etc.).
 - One of the three pieces above must be government issued in order to complete the registration process (BC Driver's License, BC Services Card, BCID or BC Care Card of parent/legal guardian).

Documents which are helpful, but not required: Health Documents (Care Card, immunization records, medical condition information)
