Children who will turn five years old before January 1, 2024 are eligible to begin school in September 2023.

**ONLINE REGISTRATION**

Online Kindergarten lottery applies to the four programs below only.

For online program application, you must first register for your local catchment school.

**HOW DO I APPLY?**

Parents must register their child online for their local catchment school prior to applying for the Kindergarten lottery.

The lottery application will begin online **Monday, January 23, 2023 at 9:00 am**. Parents will have up until **Friday, February 10, 2023 at 4:00 pm** to apply, edit and/or change their application.

**WHAT IS THE TIMELINE?**

**January 16** - Regular Kindergarten registration opens for your local school

**January 23** - Online lottery application opens

**February 8** - Deadline to register at catchment school in order to apply online for lottery programs

**February 10** - Online application closes

**February 21 to March 10** - Random lottery draw takes place

**RESULTS/ WAITLISTS**

During the weeks of **February 21 - March 10** an email will be sent to all applicants announcing the lottery results. The email will indicate whether your child has received a space in one of your selected choices and outline the next steps to accept or decline. Applicants not offered a space are automatically placed on a waitlist.

**Kindergarten registration begins Monday, January 16, 2023**

**Surrey School District is now using a web-based online registration form.**

Once submitted, the form and any supporting documents will be available to school staff and the Principal who will use their judgment to determine if documentation requirements have been satisfied. The following documents are required to complete the registration process and may be uploaded to the registration portal or presented in-person at the catchment or school-of-choice:

**PART ONE: Required documentation (does not have to be from British Columbia)**

1. Photo identification for the parent/guardian such as: driver's license, passport, Photo BC Services Card, BCID card.
2. Evidence of guardianship (as shown on child's birth certificate, or other appropriate legal documentation, such as, landed immigrant document or guardianship order).
3. Evidence of birth date for the student (e.g., birth certificate or passport).

**PART TWO: Evidence of residence for the parent/guardian in British Columbia**

4. Valid government issued documentation showing the address of residence with the name of ordinarily resident parent/guardian (e.g., BC Driver's License, BC Services Card, BCID or ICBC Registration Document, etc.).

If the above documents are not available, the Principal uses discretion to register students.
