Playground Update:

Even with Covid trying to cramp our style, we still made huge progress towards our fundraising goal this year. We started the year off with about \$24,000 in the bank earmarked for the new playground. Over the course of the school year, through hard work from our amazing team, volunteers, donors, and school community support of our fundraisers, we were able to move that needle up to \$52,966.25! We have been shooting for \$85,000, as that is what the contractors told us we needed, back in 2018. While inflation has moved that number upwards a bit, we are still very proud of this huge progress!

We still have a ways to go, so if you would like to donate to the Playground fund, or if you think your company would like to make a donation, we are still actively working towards our original goal!
