Program Outline

The Building Service Worker (BSW) Certificate program provides the working knowledge required to apply for janitorial, custodial and caretaking positions in a variety of workplace settings.

Upon successful completion of the 5-week program, students will receive BSW certification. All students who successfully complete the program will also be offered a job interview for possible employment within the Surrey School District.

Career Opportunities

Once a student has completed the Building Service Worker program offered at Surrey Community College, students will be qualified to work at:

- School districts
- Hospitals
- Care Homes
- Anywhere custodians are needed

Successful graduates who apply to the district are guaranteed an interview but must be successful in the interview to be hired.



Building Service Worker Program

Admission Requirements:

Students wishing to apply for the Building Service Worker Program must meet the following entrance requirements:

- Proof of Canadian citizenship or permanent residency: Birth Certificate, Canadian passport, Canadian citizenship Card or Permanent Residence Card Proof of secondary school completion
- Proof of Grade 10 completion
- Proof of English 10 completion
- Signed Surrey Community College application form & \$90.00 non-refundable enrolment fee

Program Structure

Intake: Several times during the year as needed

Evening: Monday to Thursday 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm

Duration: 5 weeks 80 hours

Application Fee: payable at time of registration \$ 90.00

Tuition \$ 535.00

Successfully complete. the program with a minimum mark of 70% and no more than 2 days absence
