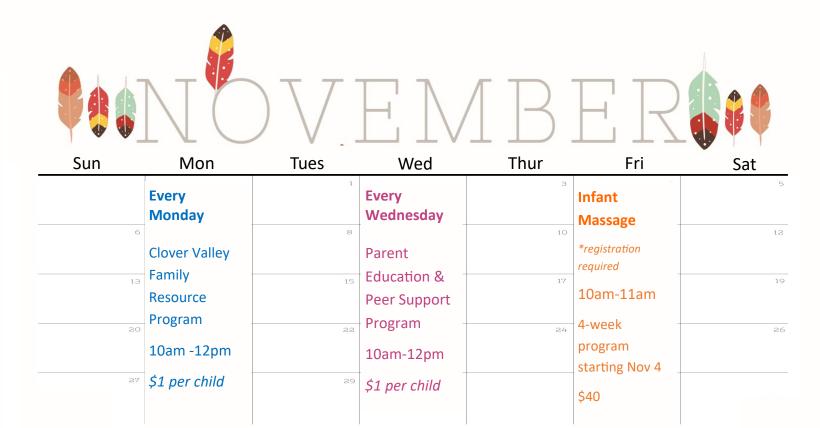


Babes & Tots: Bounces, Songs & Play!
