

## SOUTH SURREY/WHITE ROCK LEARNING CENTRE School District #36 (Surrey) CODE OF CONDUCT FORM 2020 - 2021



The South Surrey/White Rock Learning Centre is a community of over 200 students and staff. As in any community, people must work together with cooperation and understanding. This Code of Conduct has been developed by both staff and students to ensure the safe and successful operation of our school.

Our common purpose at the South Surrey/White Rock Learning Centre is to acquire knowledge, develop skills, develop positive attitudes towards learning, be responsible citizens and respect the rights and property of others. To this end, students and staff can demonstrate the attributes of a responsible member of this community by adhering to the following expectations while under the jurisdiction of the school, travelling to and from school, at school, or while at any school sponsored function.

- 1. Racism and Discrimination: All expressions of racial/ethnic bias in any form are prohibited and will be dealt with swiftly and appropriately. Any student committing an act of racist behaviour may be suspended from school and appropriate follow-up provisions will be initiated. Racism and sexism of any kind will not be tolerated.
- 2. No Violence AT ALL: Assaults will result in suspension and possible charges being laid.
- 3. No Drugs or Alcohol: Students using drugs or alcohol will be sent home. Students may be allowed to return after an interview with the parent or guardian, and an agreement is made to attend consecutive prevention sessions with an outside agency. Failure to do both will result in the student withdrawing from South Surrey/White Rock Learning Centre. A second offence will result in the student withdrawing from South Surrey/White Rock Learning Centre.
- 4. Language: Foul language is not acceptable. Repeat offenders may be asked to leave.
- 5. Attendance: Attendance is an expectation. If attendance becomes an issue, students may be subject to dismissal. Students are expected to attend four (4) classes per week and make up missed classes.
- 6. Lates: Students who are regularly late or excessively late (more than ½ hour) may be refused admittance. If you have a legitimate reason please call ahead and advise the secretary.
- 7. Signing Out: Students are expected to remain in class for the three-hour session which they attend. If students need to sign out for emergency reasons, permission from the teacher and principal is required.
- 8. School Attire: Students are expected to wear suitable clothing. Students wearing inappropriate pictures, logos or accessories, or students showing excessive skin, midriff, or undergarments, will be asked to cover up or may be sent home to change and will need to make up the session.
- 9. Technology:

You are welcome to listen to your own music, as long as it does not interfere with your own or

other's work. Computers: Computers are to be used productively and for academic purposes. Anyone using the computer during class time for anything other than curricular use (Facebook, YouTube, chat, etc.), will be asked to remove themselves from the computer for the rest of the day.

Cell Phones: No cellular phones or text messaging during class time.

10. Break: Students are not permitted to leave the school property on breaks.
