

RAPID TEST DISTRIBUTION

Kindergarten and Grade One students received their Covid rapid test kits last week, and the plan had been to send out the rest throughout last week. We received communication from the school district to halt the distribution of the tests.

In light of the recent advisory from Health Canada³ about potential risks associated with the misuse or accidental ingestion or spillage of COVID-19 rapid antigen test kit solutions, we are revising

our distribution plan for these kits for the remainder of our students. This advisory is in response to an increase in reports to poison control centres. For the remainder of the kits, we are asking parents to be the ones to receive the kits for each of their children. As you can imagine, distributing 500+ boxes directly to parents is no easy task. As such, distribution will be as follows:

Divisions 13 - 29 (Grades K -1/2) - Received their kits last week

Divisions 12 - 20 (Grades 2 - 4) - Classroom teachers will have these kits and will give them directly to parents.

For all other Divisions (Grades 4/5 - 7), kits may be picked up from the general office between 7:50 - 8:30 AM and 2:00 - 2:50 PM beginning tomorrow (Tuesday).

We recognize this is challenging for working parents but know that ensuring a safe distribution of these tests is in the best interest of our students. If you are unable to pick up your child's test and would like to make other arrangements, **please notify your child's teacher**.

Daily Health Check




If you are unsure about sending your child to school, please do the online health check at https://www.k12dailycheck.gov.bc.ca/healthcheck?execution=e1s1.

Summary: What to Do When Sick



What to do if someone is sick in your household:

You can continue to attend school if someone in your household is sick and/or self-isolating as long as you do not have any symptoms of illness and feel well. This includes if they have tested positive for COVID-19. Ensure you closely monitor yourself (or your child) for symptoms of illness and stay home if you feel unwell.
