WiFi AND INTERNET APPROPRIATE USE GUIDELINES

- School computers and other electronic devices are only to be used for school/education related activities. They are **not permitted** for social networking, gaming, illegal, obscene or inappropriate purposes. Inappropriate use includes, but is not limited to, attempts to vandalize, gain unauthorized access to data or another person's account or resources, and sharing of data without personal or parental consent as appropriate. **Personal devices are not permitted outside at recess and lunch.**
- Recording of visual images is not permissible at school unless permission has been received by the classroom teacher with respect to a classroom projects.
- Students are to be aware that they may be subject to discipline (or, if applicable, confiscation of personal property) for misuse of any technology if it negatively impacts the school environment.
- Misuse of district technology services will lead to suspension of user privileges and possible disciplinary or legal action.

USE OF PRIVATELY OWNED PERSONAL COMPUTING DEVICES

School District No. 36 (Surrey) authorizes the use of privately owned personal computers/devices within the school's communications network as a tool to support learning in the classroom.

Computer/Device owners agree to:

- Adhere fully to the SD36 Acceptable Use Policy (see above) and that computer/device and network usage will also be governed by school and classroom rules and expectations
- Strictly ensure that software installed on their privately owned computer/device are licensed for their use
- Give their computer/device an appropriate machine name

SD36 and schools are NOT responsible for:

- Repair of privately owned computers/electronic devices (hardware or software)
- Compatibility problems with its networks, computers, and software
- Network connectivity problems
- Theft of or damage to privately owned computers/devices, software, or data
- Providing licenses for software used on privately owned computers/devices

Procedures:

- Students connect to the SD36 network and must register their device
- Schools communicate procedures around in class and break time use of devices
- Students conduct themselves in a responsible, ethical, and polite manner in accordance with the District's code of conduct with their devices.
- Students using personal devices would be expected to act in the same manner as when using district devices.
