Tomorrow is our first day back in the Raven's Nest

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we look to open school tomorrow. Tomorrow we welcome grade 1 - 4 at 9:00 - 10:00 and our Grade 5 -7 at 11:00-12:00. Kindergarten students come at 12:30 according to the schedule we sent you. We can't wait to see you!

When you come to school remember to keep 2 meters apart from other students and staff.

We have designated zones on the field for different grade groups. Grade 1s will meet on the gravel field by the trees beside the Kindergarten rooms. Grade 2 will meet farther out on the field towards the east side of the field past the long jump pit beside the parking lot. Grade 3 students will meet on the field next to the play ground and grade 4s will be met out on the gravel field by the basket ball court. Please make your way to your zone. There you will see teachers in orange vests with signs indicating which group you are in. Most groups will be no more than 8 students.

For the 11:00 slot grade 5 will meet by the trees, 6 by the parking lot and long jump pit and 7s beside the basketball court. **Again, please be sure to maintain social distance of 2 meters.**

K students are a much smaller group and will meet by the trees next to the K rooms. Below is the information that was sent out last week. I include it for your reference.

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Thursday and Friday, September, 10 & 11, 2020 (for students planning to attend face-to-face full time only)

In order to adhere to the Health & Safety Guidelines, as students are welcomed into school on September 10 & 11, they will need to remain physically distanced. This will require many teachers to be involved in the orientation process, as students will be spread throughout the school in small numbers. Students will attend orientation at the following times:
