

## **FUNDING ELIGIBLE – Frequently Asked Questions**

### **1. School Placement:**

#### **Elementary Schools:**

We place at initial registration only. Placement is done by catchment (school close to home as defined by district boundaries), and is subject to space availability.

#### **Secondary Schools:**

Students are placed by catchment (school close to home as defined by district boundaries).

### **2. School Changes/Transfers:**

After placement has been made at the time of initial application, if parent wishes to transfer child to another school, parent must take the currently valid Letter of Acceptance and go to the school desired. If parent has moved to a new address, take proof of home address as well. Request school staff for registration. If school agrees and completes the registration, school staff will let us know and we will update our records.

### **3. Permanent Resident Status:**

International Funding Eligible Students who have received permanent residence, submit Permanent Resident (PR) cards or Confirmation of Permanent Resident Document for both parent(s) and all children registered with Surrey Schools.

On receipt of the documents, we will withdraw your child from International Funding Eligible and inform the school about the change in status. This means that you will be able to register your child directly at the school every year.
