Kindergarten Registration

If you have a child who attends here and a younger sibling(birth year 2017) who will be starting kindergarten in September, you will need to enroll them. It is not automatic.

Registration began MONDAY, JANUARY 10th, 2022. Children who will turn five years old before January 1st, 2023 are eligible to begin school in September 2022. The Surrey School District is only using a web-based online registration form.

Documents Required:

- 1. Proof of birthdate for the student (birth certificate or passport)
- 2. Proof of guardianship as shown on child's birth certificate, or other appropriate legal documentation such as landed immigrant document or guardian ship order
- Proof of Citizenship for both the parent and student (Canadian Birth Certificate, Citizenship Card Passport, Landed Immigrant Document, Permanent Resident Card, Enhanced Driver's License or Enhanced Identification Card)
- 4. Proof of residence of parent/guardian
 - a. Three pieces of identification showing the address of residence within school catchment (purchase or rental agreement, utility bill, driver's license, etc.)
 - b. One of the three pieces above must be government issued in order to complete the registration (BC Driver's license, BCID, BC Care Card, etc.)
- 5. Documents that are helpful, but not required
 - a. Health Documents (Care card, immunization records, medical condition information)
