SCHOOL DROP OFF AND PICK UP

MANY DRIVERS continue to ignore and blatantly break the rules. We are trying to provide a safe environment for ALL our students. When you disregard the protocols in place you are putting CHILDREN AT RISK.

Please look at the front of the planner for a map of how to pick up and drop off. Our rules are simple:

- 1. if you are picking up and are here longer than 5 minutes, PARK your car in the lot and walk up
- 2. the driveway cannot be blocked
- 3. there are 2 lanes-one is for quick pick up/drop off/ the other is for driving through.



We know sometimes you need to drive your child. Please consider WALKING or having your children WALK in a group to school.

We do not want someone to get seriously injured or killed. BE RESPONSIBLE!!!!

DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP

SNOW in January--look to CKNW and the district for updates on school closures....

In the event of snow in January, please remember to check the district website.

Schools will normally remain open unless there is damage or circumstances that make it unsafe to operate. Parents and staff have responsibility to make decisions regarding attendance at school due to challenging weather conditions, based on available travel routes and individual circumstances. Access to our school parking lot and drop off area may be limited due to snowfall. Please walk to school if possible, to lessen traffic congestion.

If the school is closed, it will be announced on the Surrey School District website <u>www.sd36.bc.ca</u> and on the following radio stations: CKNW (980 AM) CBC Radio (690 AM) News 1130 (1130 AM) Radio India (1600AM)

If it snows please do not call the school to see if it is open, check stations above. Call the office only if you are not going to be sending your child to school.

Dress for the Weather!

Now that the fall weather is here and the rainy/snowy season has begun, please be sure to dress your child appropriately. Unless the weather is exceptionally stormy, the children **go outside** for fresh air and exercise at recess and lunch. If your child is too ill to go outside, they are too ill to be at school. Please send your child in a weather proof jacket (not just a hoodie), hat, gloves and boots so that they can play in comfort.

When there is snow/ice, the blacktop areas are extremely slippery. Please exercise caution and plan extra time to get to classes. We salt as much as possible but that does not eliminate the chances of slipping. Proper footwear and taking extra time move about will help to ensure everyone's safety.

Kindergarten Registration

Registration began MONDAY, JANUARY 10th, 2022. Children who will turn five years old before January 1st, 2023 are eligible to begin school in September 2022.

The Surrey School District is only using a web-based online registration form.

Please click the link <u>here</u> to complete the online registration for Kindergarten registration. When registering, please remember to select 2022-2023 school year.

Documents Required:

- 1. Proof of birthdate for the student (birth certificate or passport)
- 2. Proof of guardianship (as shown on child's birth certificate, or other appropriate legal documentation such as landed immigrant document or guardian ship order
- Proof of Citizenship for both the parent and student (Canadian Birth Certificate, Citizenship Card Passport, Landed Immigrant Document, Permanent Resident Card, Enhanced Driver's License or Enhanced Identification Card)
- 4. Proof of residence of parent/guardian
 - a. Three pieces of identification showing the address of residence within school catchment (purchase or rental agreement, utility bill, driver's license, etc.)
 - b. One of the three pieces above must be government issued in order to complete the registration (BC Driver's license, BCID, BC Care Card, etc.)
- 5. Documents that are helpful, but not required
 - a. Health Documents (Care card, immunization records, medical condition information)
