Step 4: Go to MyEdBC here (or https://myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do)

Your Username will be your student number. Your password is whatever you set it last year. If you can't remember, you can reset the password and it will be sent via email. If this is still not working, go here or https://www.surreyschools.ca/schools/johnht/About/Courses/Pages/default.aspx

Note 1: There are situations where your specific needs are different than what is listed on the sheet. Perhaps you took a course in Summer School, or need a specific program not listed. In these cases, when you enter your details in MyEdBC, there will be a Notes field. Counsellors will read these notes and make adjustments as needed.

Note 2: Changes to requests via MyEdBC will be open until February 12th. After that date, course changes will be limited and many courses will have waitlists. It is important that you make accurate decisions prior to February 12th.
