



Program Outline

This 10 month Hairdressing Certificate program is designed to provide a strong foundation in the trade of Hairdressing. Combined studies in beauty council of practical, theory of Cosmetology, technical, and artistic training prepare the student for the Cosmetology Industry Association of BC Examination and seek employment in the salon industry. This program is held in a fully-equipped salon.

Admission Requirements

Students wishing to apply for the Hairdressing Certificate Program must meet the following entrance requirements:

- Proof of Canadian citizenship or permanent residency: Birth Certificate, Canadian Passport, Canadian Citizenship Card or Permanent Residence Card.
- Minimum Grade 10 completion.
- Applicants must provide evidence of acceptable levels of reading, speaking and understanding the English language. An assessment may be required.
- Must be at least 17 years of age.
- Successful interview with the instructor.
- Signed Surrey Community College application form and an \$90.00 non-refundable registration fee.

Career Opportunities

Once a student has completed the Hairdressing Certificate Program offered at Surrey Community College, students are qualified to work as:

- Hairstylist in a salon
- Self-employed hairstylist
- Educator for colour lines or supply companies
- Platform artist
- Film industry hairstylist

Graduation Requirements

Students must successfully complete all the required courses in order to receive their Diploma. They must achieve a minimum of 70% final grade for each course
