Dear Parent / Guardian,

Our school has been advised by the Principal at Clayton Heights that a female Grade 12 student was confronted by an adult male who was committing an indecent act near 188th Street and 70th Avenue at 3:45 pm on February 28th. The student was not physically harmed. The Surrey RCMP are investigating.

I am sharing this information with students and parents so you are aware and can take precautions as needed in the neighbourhood. In the meantime, anyone with information is asked to call Surrey RCMP at 604-599-0502.

As a reminder, here are some safety tips:

- · Don't take short cuts. Use main routes...avoid lanes, forested or secluded areas.
- · Walk with friends.
- · Tell someone where you are going and when you will be back.
- · Phone home when leaving a friend's house and say when you will be home.
- · Trust your instincts and your feelings.
- · Phone if you are going to be delayed, or if your plans change.
