Our School Plan

For the last couple of months, we have been reviewing and updating our school plan goal. We are continuing to focus on Social Emotional Learning. However, our focus has shifted to our students' conflict resolution skills. We have found that many of our children have a challenging time negotiating the regular conflicts that occur within and outside of the classroom. Trying to resolve a conflict when feeling angry or upset, not having possible solutions to try, not having empathy for the other person involved, or using physical means to solve problems have all been observed in many situations. For the next few months and continuing into next year, teachers will be working with students to help them build empathy skills, learn bully prevention strategies, and acquire peaceful methods for solving conflicts. Teachers will be using a program called Second Step to teach these skills.

Our hope is we can all work together to create a safe and caring school experience for our children. April 9th-13th. Students wishing to audition need to sign up on the schedule in front of the office which will be posted the week before the auditions.


Students can perform a talent of their choice and must come prepared to the auditions **with props and/or music needed.**
