## Martha Currie safety protocols...

- High touch areas are being cleaned at least twice a day when students are in session
- Tables, desks, and chairs are being wiped and disinfected with District Health & Safety approved materials at least once per day when students are not in the classroom
- If a student or staff member goes home ill with Covid-like symptoms, that classroom is immediately cleaned and disinfected
- Fogging is happening in all classrooms and portables after school hours
- Handwashing and/or sanitizing is occurring whenever students enter or leave a classroom, as well as before and after eating
- Social distancing is required outside of cohorts when students and staff are inside the building; masks are being used by staff members if social distancing is not possible
- All students and staff were provided with re-usable cloth masks at the beginning of the school year
- Students are always welcomed to wear masks
- The office has a limited supply of masks available, if required
- There is minimal student movement in hallways to limit contact
- There are directional arrows on the floor of our hallways to help guide staff and students to walk on the right
- Classroom lineups are spread out outside, to help maintain distance between classes and limit number of classes using each doorway
- Outside Recess and Lunch times are staggered to provide students with more space when playing
- If more than 10% of students in a class are absent at one time for the same reason, the custodial department is contacted and a deep clean is planned for that evening

• If there are any exposures, Fraser Health will contact families directly and the school will be notified by Fraser Health what next steps will be

## You can help us out by...

- Completing the <u>Daily Health Check</u> on your child(ren) each day and keeping them home if they have any symptoms
- Physically distancing from all adults and students when on the school grounds
- Wearing a mask when on school grounds, if you are able to
- Calling the office to make an appointment, if you need to enter the school, and wearing a mask if you do enter the building for an appointment
- Leaving the school grounds once you have collected your children at the end of the day
- Reminding your child(ren) about the protocols in place and the importance of distancing from others
