Dear Parents/Guardians:

Each school year, we provide parents with an outline of the projected fees that are expected for the following year. We appreciate all the support our parents provide to ensure our students have a successful year. In addition to providing the school supplies itemized on a grade list, periodically parents are asked for monies to cover specific items and special events.

As per School Board Policy No. 9802—School Fees: The Board shall provide instruction free of charge to all students registered in a school's education program sufficient to meet the general requirements for graduation, and it shall provide free of charge any resource materials necessary to participate in that program. The Board may, however, charge fees for optional educational resource materials which come into the possession of the student.

School Supplies:

This year we will be offering the option of school wide pre-ordered supply kits through School Start (forms and online ordering will be available no later than June 14). Students in grades 1-7 will also receive a supply list at the end of this school year should parents choose not to pre-order school supplies.

Kindergarten Supplies:

In Kindergarten all supplies are shared in the classroom. The school purchases the supplies in bulk for all kindergarten students. We ask that Kindergarten parents pay \$40.00 toward the purchase of the supplies.

Student Planners:

We recommend that all students in grades 1-7 purchase a Clayton Elementary planner at a cost of **\$5.00**. We find this to be an excellent tool for facilitating home/school communication, as well as for developing our students' organizational skills. Using our school planner is optional, as a parent may purchase their own.

<u>Music</u>

Musical Instruments: Grade 3-5 students may learn to play the recorder. Students will have the option of purchasing one through our music teacher for \$5 or receiving one on loan from the school. Also, our Grade 7 students who opt for/take band either purchase or rent an instrument. Costs vary depending on the instrument.

Please note - No student will be denied the opportunity to participate in any school activity due to the inability to pay. Please contact the Principal should you require any financial assistance.
