Power Outage Procedures:

First of all, thank-you to our incredibly responsive parent community for their help on Thursday. It made a big difference! Here are a few items to note should this type event occur again:

- Our phones do not work in a power outage and we are relying on my district cell phone to keep you informed. I can receive emails through my phone, so please always email me (not the school account) at Fenrick_1@surreyschools.ca if you need to make contact.
- We will try to update with alerts and emails as information changes. Please note that the alerts trigger a notification through the School Link App on your mobile device if you have the app downloaded.
- Parents will only be called if we have a true emergency and we need immediate pick up of students. We are fully equipped to deal with a power outage and do not consider this a true emergency. Students are safe and we have flashlights for the washrooms. We inform parents via the website, emails, and if possible, the unofficial parent Facebook page which is run by some of our PAC members of the outage and leave it to your discretion as to whether or not to pick up early.

I hope that answers any questions you have but if not, please feel free to email me to ask. Student safety is our first and foremost concern at all times and I want you to feel confident should a situation occur. Thank-you to the staff who came together and helped all the students enjoy an adventure!
