Health and Safety

A few reminders:

- Please check with your child every morning before sending them to school and keep them home if they are showing any signs of illness – we have to assume that any illness could be Omicron, and the more we keep illness out of our schools, the more likely we are to be able to stay open for in-person instruction
- Send your child with two masks (if possible) every day and ensure they are properly fitting
- Wear a mask if you are on school property
- If you need to talk to the office, please call or come to the front entrance and ring the bell
- If you need to talk to your child's teacher, please call them through the office, email them directly, or see them outside the building

Weather

As you can imagine, our grounds are covered in snow that is slowly melting. This means that it will most likely be wet when students are outside. We ask that you send them dressed for the weather and send an extra full pair of clothes (including socks and underwear). This is a good idea for all students, even our older ones, to eliminate the need for us to call you to bring them a change of clothes should they get wet.

Also, our parking lot has large piles of snow, which has taken a number of our parking spots and further complicates an already tight space. Please be patient, be kind, and go slow. Leave some additional time in the morning so we can all make it to school on time. If you have a student in Grades 1 or older, please try to drop off and leave so we can keep the few spots we have for our Kindergarten parents who need to bring their children directly to the doors of their classrooms. There is supervision at 8:15 on our playground, so it is safe to leave children any time after that.
