- Divs 1-3 – 12:30pm to 1:30pm

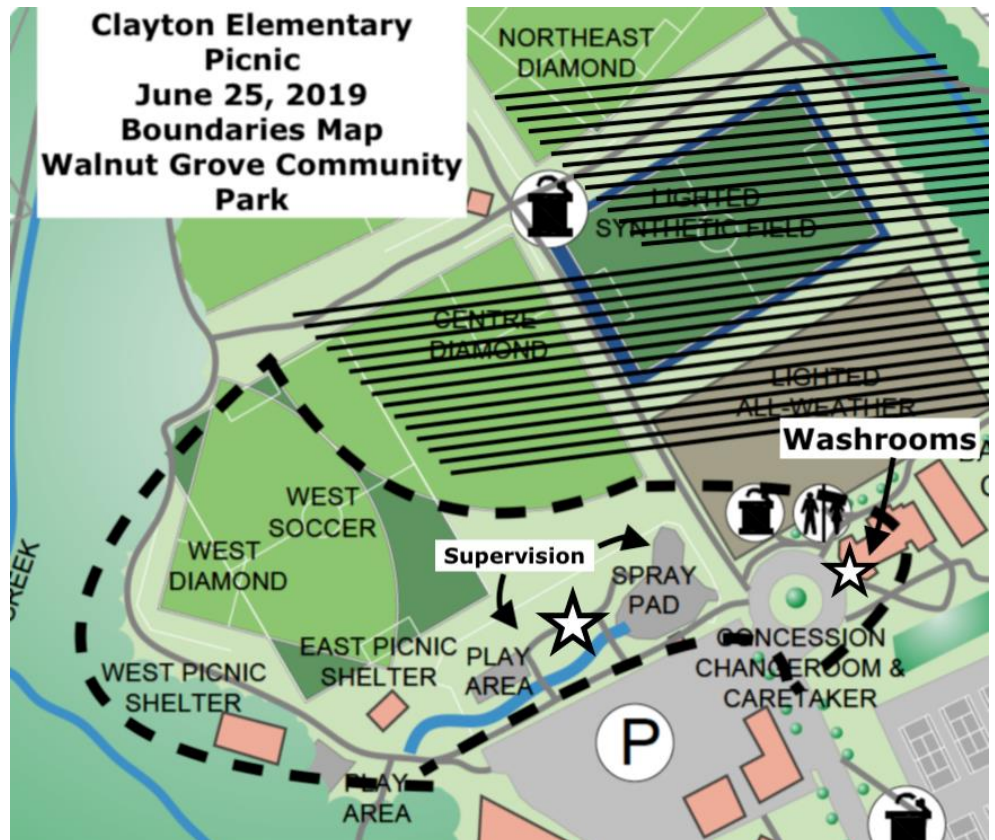
1:45 – All students – gather with their teacher

# 30 LITTLE THINGS THAT MEAN A LOT TO KIDS

- Go for a walk with just one child.
- Build your own Minecraft world alongside his.
