Parking and School drop off before and after school

Every year, we like to remind parents and caregivers about our parking rules. These are rules that make our very difficult parking lot work and keep everyone safe. We completely understand there are many challenges with our parent parking lot, lack of sidewalks, and lack of space to park at all. Our staff are out there trying their best to keep the traffic moving and most importantly, keep our students and families safe. We urge you to listen if they give direction, to follow the rules, and show patience. Having patience is our best method to keeping everyone safe.

1. Staff parking lot:

The staff parking lot is for staff, our daycare buses (as they need turn around space) and for some our parents who have special permission due to their children's special needs. Please use the drop off/pick up area for ALL students and at ALL TIMES. These rules apply TO ALL PARENT AND CAREGIVERS both before and after school and regardless if you are late. If we see parents pulling into our staff lot, we will be asking you to move to the parent lot.

2. Parent lot and thru lane:

Thank-you to all those parents who properly use the thru lane. The middle lane is not for stopping and getting out of your car. We ask that if you do not see your child ready to come to your car, that you go through, do a loop and try again. Stopping and getting out of your car to get your child from the playground backs up the whole system down 184th.

3. Courtesy to our neighbours:

We have one neighbor to the south of the school that has a long driveway with a gate. Please do not park in front of it at any time. There are no parking signs in front of that driveway.

4. The no-stopping zone right across from the school (east side of 184th)

This area has a no-stopping sign directly on it. Please do not pull over there and stop or park. This spot helps those community members get around our line up and helps to alleviate the frustration of other drivers with our traffic lines. It is also very unsafe for children to cross to this area as the traffic is very heavy at these times.

5. Options:

- a. Walk or bike to school great fresh air and exercise
- b. Park a little farther down 184th (north and south) and then walk a block or two to school

I truly recognize the frustrations that occur at drop off and pick up times. This has always been a huge issue at Clayton. Our site is extremely limited and not going to change. If everyone follows the rules, parks only in designated spots, pulls through and does loops if necessary, when picking up and/or parks a few blocks away and walks a bit, it makes it run as smoothly as it possibly can. Following the rules and having patience with each other are important things to model for our kids. Thank-you for your cooperation with this.

And we only have one more school year to deal with this headache – one of the many great things about moving our school to Regent Road Elementary!
