Student verification and other forms

Student verification, media and other consent forms for our Grades 1-7 students went home this week, and our Kindergarten Cougars will receive theirs on Monday when their classroom teacher is set. If things change for you – address/phone numbers – throughout the year, please contact the office to let us know through email or a phone call. Please know that if you have moved or do move throughout the year, your child is still welcome at our school even if they are no longer in our catchment.

FreshGrade forms for those teachers who are either using this as their reporting tool or as a celebration portfolio are coming home today. This is a new form for this year, so please read it thoroughly. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact your child’s teacher or Mrs. Fenrick at the office. Teachers have the choice to either use the FreshGrade platform or a paper template for their reporting to parents. This is up to each individual teacher. All students receive a paper summative report at the end of the year.

Meet the teacher night/community picnic – Sept 23

Typically, we have a Community BBQ and meet the teacher night. As we are still not allowed to serve food, we are hoping to get district permission to still do an in-person Community Picnic. The idea is that families would bring their own food or snacks to an outdoor event where we can gather and eat together as a community – weather permitting. We are waiting for final confirmation from the district if we are allowed to have this type of event and it would have to be cancelled if the weather was not cooperating. I will send an email out next week if we get

that permission. Teachers will also be sending out a video introducing themselves and letting you see what the classroom is like. We did this last year and got a lot of great feedback on it.
