Communicating Student Learning



It's time to start thinking about the more formal aspects of Communicating Student Learning (CSL). Here are a few important events coming up before the holidays:

- Early dismissal is at 1:35 pm on December 9. During this time, teachers will be meeting with parents via phone, TEAMS and in person. (pre scheduled appointments). This is a time for parent teacher conferences.
- Please take some time out of your busy schedule to view your child's FreshGrade digital portfolio. Your child's digital portfolio is the main way your child's teacher will be sharing learning progress. If you have not yet accessed your child's digital portfolio, or don't know how, please reach out to your child's teacher.
- Home conversations around your child's learning make a huge difference. We all know that the standard question of "How was your day?" or "What did you do at school today?" will automatically trigger the responses, "Good" or "Nothing." A peek at your child's digital portfolio in addition to specific questions will ignite more open conversation. <u>Please feel free to use the following PROMPTS</u> at home to get these conversations started.

Families Travelling Outside of Canada

We are still receiving questions and wanted to clarify the information we have received about students travelling outside of Canada. For students re-entering Canada travelling with vaccinated parents and a negative COVID test, quarantine is waived, **but school is not included in the exceptions.** So, all children that are unvaccinated (including under 12) must not attend school for 14 days after returning to Canada. Parking





A few friendly reminders about our parking lot to keep our students safe and make drop off and pick up easy and stress free:

- Please give yourself time to drop off and pick up your child.
- Our parking lot is for staff only, with some spaces for visitor parking
- Please do not double park in front of cars in the drop off area and wait for your children. Rather, please leave the lot and line up to make another pass and meet your child. Cars that are idling in front of the school will be asked to circle around and come back into the lot.
- When dropping off and picking up students in front of the school, please have children exit and enter vehicles on the passenger side.
- We encourage parents to park off site, meet your child at their classroom door or a designated meeting spot, and then walk with your children to your vehicle.
- Please follow the parking signs such as, No Parking in front of drop off loop and No Left Turn signs
- Please keep your speed slow in and around our school. Thank you for your cooperation.

Dress for the Weather



1 - It is important children get outside for some fresh air at morning and lunch recess times. Students will be sent outside for recess times (please see below criteria) and should be dressed for the weather. Please send your children with rain jackets, umbrellas, and rain boots to ensure their comfort during our outdoor recess times and the learning time in the classroom afterward. Please send an extra set of clothes in your child's backpack.

- 5 degrees or below and raining
- Raining and so windy umbrellas will turn inside out
- Raining very hard duration and intensity is great

Outside Day

- Above 5 degrees and raining
