

The Vancouver Fraser Port Authority's school program helps students build awareness about the port, the role it plays, and how it connects to their everyday life. The program offers a memorable, interactive and fun learning and field trip experience.

Students learn about Canada's largest and most diversified port through activities such as:

- Map puzzle How large is our port? Students assemble a map puzzle of Canada's largest port, and explore familiar landmarks, alongside new ones, in relation to your school.
- Connecting your port city trivia challenge Students answer questions and test their knowledge of the port on touch-screen benches.
- Cargo relay Students work together as terminal operators and try their hand at loading various cargo types in this 'get up and go' activity.
- **Enviro quiz** Students discover what makes the Port of Vancouver a sustainable port, while thinking critically about their own environmental stewardship during this fun, object-based guessing game.
- Import story Students learn how far oranges travel, and how many jobs are connected with our port, while wearing costumes and reading scripts in the 'journey of an orange.'
- Scavenger hunt Students learn more about the port as they search for answers on our interactive touch screen benches.
