## A Word from Your Principal

As the first formal reporting period approaches this week (**Report Cards go home on Tuesday, December 1<sup>st</sup>**), I want to remind you that there will be different ways to communicate your child's learning and growth:

- the standard, two-page district report card;
- a new, four-page district report card called Communicating Student Learning. This format includes both teacher and student self-assessments of learning. A letter went home last week to let parents know this was the format your child's teacher would be using.
- Freshgrade, which is an online digital portfolio parents can access anytime. Teachers using this platform have been communicating regularly with parents since September. Teachers will be sending home a hard copy of some student self-assessments of their learning.

It is our intent that there are no surprises at report card time. Communicating your child's learning is an ongoing process that occurs through conversations with teachers, visits in the classroom, on field trips, and during student-led conferences throughout the calendar year. We hope you feel welcome to discuss your child's progress at any time, and **we look forward to meeting with you on Thursday following early dismissal at 1.30pm for parent/teacher learning conferences. Please contact the office to make your appointment with your child's teacher(s).**
