Parking Lot Update

- February 9th Deadline to register at catchment school in order to apply online for Choice Program
- February 15th Online applications close
- February 22nd Random draw for lottery takes place
- February 23rd March 4 Lottery results sent to applicants for accept and decline or with wait list placements via email
