Communicating Student Learning (CSL)

The two choices that teachers have to communicate learning to parents are a digital portfolio (FreshGrade) with regular online postings about student progress throughout the year and/or a paper template that reports on a whole term’s worth of learning received at the end of each of the three terms. We have some teachers who choose to use the digital portfolio to show some extra insight into the classroom combined with the paper template as their reporting tool.

For those students whose teachers who use FreshGrade to communicate student learning, we have finally been given the go ahead from the district to start the process. If your child’s teacher uses FreshGrade, you should be getting an invitation in your email soon to access their portfolio.
