2020 HOLIDAY FOOD/FUND DRIVE INFORMATION

Thank you for supporting the Surrey Food Bank! Holding a Holiday Food/Fund Drive is wonderful way to build community spirit within your school. The following information will help us get you the supplies necessary, and ensure we have your food pick up scheduled.

1. Registering your Holiday Food/Fund drive

- a) Please complete the attached form and email or fax to events@surreyfoodbank.org or 604.588.8697.
- b) Please allow 2 3 business days for a response due to a high volume of requests. We appreciate your patience and understanding.

2. Supply Pick Up/ Drop Off and Donation Drop Off

- a) Supplies and/or donations (food/cash) can be picked-up or dropped-off at our office Monday to Friday, 8:30 AM 3:00 PM. Please note our NEW address: 13478 78th Ave, Surrey.
- b) If you require supply delivery, please indicate your preferred drop off date on the second page. Our driver will deliver supplies Monday to Friday from 8:00 AM 2:00 PM. Our offices are closed on weekends.
- c) Monetary donations can also be mailed in, called in via telephone or made online through our website www.surreyfoodbank.org/donate.

3. Donation Pick Up

- a) Our drivers will pick up donations from Monday, December 14th to Friday, December 18th only. PLEASE schedule your pick-up now to ensure a pick-up date. Clearly indicate the specific date and time that you would like your pick-up on the second page. We will <u>try</u> to meet your request.
- b) Donations of cash or cheques should be **removed** from the SFB cash can by the school and the funds sealed in the envelope provided. Please sign the back of the envelope, across the seal. Hand the sealed envelope with funds as well as the cash can to the driver. If you find you have a large donation of mixed coins, we ask that you try to separate the coins by denomination. This will help us a lot during this busy time.
- c) When making up your boxes, please tape the bottoms. Once a donation box is full, ensure it can be closed flat and taped closed. Each box should be taped on the bottom and taped closed.
- d) The boxes should be stacked in the lobby or near the door, easily accessible to our drivers who will be managing many pickups each day.
- e) Your students are more than welcome to help us load the trucks.
- f) Due to liability issues, we do not deliver or pick up donations from private residences.
