Office 365 migration – Tuesday March 12th – Evening – Important Information

As part of Office 365 implementation, IMS will migrate the email accounts of AbEd staff to the cloud on Tuesday evening, March 12. (IMS has already completed all Secondary, Elementary and Learning Centres staff accounts.) IMS staff will be present at our Wednesday March 13th staff meeting to troubleshoot any issues that you may experience in the migration.

Please note that desktop email access and functionality will remain the same, but there will be some steps required for iPad users to continue to access email after Tuesday evening. (See <u>detailed instructions</u>).

- Most users: Mobile devices (iPads): Devices will need to be powered down and restarted. Depending on the device, district email accounts may need to deleted and re-added.
- A few users: If you access shared calendars or mailboxes (XXXX-Office, iPad bookings, etc.) they may need to be re-shared from the owner's account.
- A few users: Office 365 profile: If you have been assigned a phone number in your profile, verify that the phone # that displays is correct or blank.
