## Intro to Construction Trades Sampler Summer 2019 – for graduating students (Gr12)

July 8 - August 16 on Annacis Island (Delta) Contact Career Center for more information.

(There is no tuition.)

Students are given the following funds to assist with participation:

- \$38/week for transportation
- \$13/day for lunch in our on-site restaurant
- \$250 for PPE (work boots and coveralls)

Students will experience welding, piping, floor covering installation, scaffolding, finishing trades (e.g. interior wall systems). Other trades like carpentry, electrical, sheet metal, insulation will be incorporated if instructors/facilities are available.
