ACTIVE INCLUSION PROGRAM (AIP) I DIGITAL DELIVERY

AIP is designed to use contemporary dance to encourage a healthy conversation about discrimination, intolerance, hate, & racism as a method for increasing attachment to Canada in youth-at-risk. Because of the ongoing pandemic, SQx is delivering our new program online.

FINAL VIDEO PRODUCTION: Teachers will take videos and photos of participants at specific points in the program. Footage is collated in the development of the final production, which will be shared with classes on the last day of the program.

ARTS EDUCATION CURRICULUM PARALLELS: AIP encourages participants to use dance to explore physical literacy, identity, place, culture, society, & belonging through the arts by

ABOUT SQx: We are a registered Canadian charity based in South Slocan, BC. Our mission is to use contemporary dance to promote kinship, collaboration, & teamwork. We further the development of dance and public engagement through performance and outreach programming. Our work has been presented across Canada and Europe and also in Mexico and Morocco. We have 13 staff representing diverse underrepresented populations:

- 100% Female
- 92% Youth (below age 30)
- 46% Bilingual
- 38% BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Colour)
- 23% LGBTQ2S+
- 23% Disability
- 15% Francophone
- 15% Remote & Rural
- 8% Newcomers

We have hiring preferences because our work targets vulnerable populations. Therefore, it is critical that our staff represent & reflect the audiences that we serve. Hiring from underrepresented populations is critical to the identity of the organization, & it is how we work towards continuously improve our organization & programming to ensure that to our work considers the experiences of diverse participants.
