The environment at GLC is robust, and is anchored in a culture that is conducive to learning. As a staff, we have high expectations of all members of our learning community, and firmly believe that **students who attend will be successful**. Our school will continue to provide and maintain a culture that is safe, caring and healthy; a culture where regular, daily attendance is the norm, where cooperative attitudes, mutual understanding, and strong work ethic is engendered, encouraged and valued.

Guildford Learning Centre is a school where we learn and work together. It is a school where building relationships is of primary importance (relationships are the "key app"!). We believe that when strong, healthy relationships exist between staff and students, and the school and home, learning will happen. We strive to connect students with our school, with learning, with staff, with their peers to create a sense of belonging, to build and secure a strong school community. For our learning community to function well, it is imperative that all members use good judgement and endeavour to do what is right at all times, that we conduct ourselves with the best of intentions. It is our expectation, and the responsibility of each student, to attend, learn and make progress. Appropriate consequences will be applied if attitude/behaviour and/or attendance hinder achievement, or when incongruous behaviours place the learning, and/or the health and safety of others in jeopardy. GLC, as with all schools, has a fair and reasonable Student/School Code of Conduct, outlining expectations for behaviours/conduct. Adhering to the Student Code of Conduct helps to ensure that GLC is a welcoming, respectful, healthy and safe environment for all who enter the doors.

We are a continuous entry program, meaning that students can be accepted into the school throughout the year. However, once enrollment has reached capacity, waiting lists are established, and students from the waitlist will be accommodated when space comes available. The course offerings are diverse, with delivery of the curriculum defined as student centred/self—directed. Teachers guide, coach and facilitate students through the courses via one-on-one instruction, small groups and inquiry/project based learning. We strive to provide an environment that is collaborative, one where students have a voice to help ensure that their learning is meaningful/relevant and educational needs are met. We want our students to know they are strongly supported in pursuit of their academic, career and personal goals.

The educational/learning process always works best when all stakeholders are involved; therefore, we encourage and value parental input. If you have a concern regarding your child's educational program/progress, be sure to contact the school. If there is a concern originating from within the school, every attempt to make contact with home is undertaken to ensure that a parent/guardian is made aware of the situation. We also like to inform parents of all the wonderful things their children are doing via "good news phone calls" or letters send home!
