What we are:

Cloverdale Learning Centre is a secondary school of choice located in the heart of Cloverdale. We offer small class sizes, mentor teachers, close student monitoring and an excellent educational program that allows students to obtain their standard high school Dogwood certificate or Adult Dogwood certificate required for graduation. We have continual entry to allow you to become part of our family environment at any time during the school year. Students can attend mornings, afternoon or all day sessions. In addition to the subject and elective offerings, students have the opportunity to build basic employment skills, participate in work placements and work apprenticeship programs. We offer courses that allow students to earn dual credits at post-secondary institutions while also receiving credit towards graduation. Our staff consists of a full time school counselor, full time career facilitator, youth and childcare worker, inner city worker, aboriginal support and amazing teachers who are subject experts and love kids.

Who can attend?

Students must be 15 to 19 years of age and possess the necessary prerequisites for grade 10. Students deficient in these prerequisites may apply and acceptance will be at the discretion of the principal.

Application Process?

- Referral form from current school, district counsellor or contact CLC for options.
- Registration and Initial Assessment completed at CLC (if needed)
- Schedule Intake meeting with the Principal of CLC
